

## MDCB AWARDED RCEEM STATUS

The MDCB board of directors is happy to announce that MDCB has been granted ***Recognized Continuing Education Evaluation Mechanism*** (RCEEM) status with ARRT. The MDCB has worked closely with the AAMD to address feedback received from the 2007 AAMD membership survey requesting that continuing education credits approved by MDCB be reciprocal for ARRT credit. ARRT will now allow the CE activities that are approved by the MDCB and that are relevant to the duties and responsibilities of a Medical Dosimetrist to be awarded ARRT Category A credit.

ARRT has identified a number of issues that are important to the CE evaluation process and should be addressed by every RCEEM:

- All CE activities intended for use by Medical Dosimetrists must meet ARRT's definition of a **Continuing Education Activity**. In order to qualify as continuing education, the activity must be planned, organized and provide sufficient depth and scope of a subject area.
- **Documentation** or proof of participation in a particular educational activity is required. The documentation must be in the form of a certificate and include: name of participant, dates of attendance, title and content of activity, number of contact hours for the activity, name of sponsor, signature of the instructor or an authorized representative of the sponsor issuing the documentation, and a reference number if the activity has been approved by a RCEEM.
- ARRT does award 24 Category A credits for the initial MDCB certification exam. ARRT will not accept the MDCB re-examination to satisfy the ARRT CE requirements.

The MDCB board of directors will continue to strive to improve the services provided to its members.
